Important Safety Tips for Users:

Never Travel Alone.

Always tell someone where you are going and when you expect to return.

Bring a map of the area you are traveling, and a compass (and know how to use it) .

Do not rely exclusively on your GPS or smartphone, as reception can fail and batteries can die.

Be prepared for emergencies.

Before you go, familiarize yourself with any possible exit points.

Be aware of weather conditions. The weather changes quickly in the

Be willing to turn back if circumstances call for abandoning a tour. Bring a first aid kit.

Pack extra clothes, food and other aids to ward off hypothermia in case of emergency.

- 1. Plan Ahead and Prepare
- 2. Travel and Camp on Durable Surfaces
- 3. Dispose of Waste Properly
- 4. Leave What You Find
- 5. Minimize Campfire Impacts
- 6. Respect Wildlife
- 7. Be Considerate of Other Visitors
