# Meeting called to order at 5:05pm

#### **Review:**

- 1. Notes from 07/13 meeting on weather related emergency response, VT state notes and FEMA fact sheet
  - a. Town heads met after the big storm
  - b. PD received a lot of calls for Wardsboro, offered to have Candace come in and help with calls if needed
  - c. Planning to do training for some new people on VT Alert system in case it is needed for future emergency events
  - d. Late summer/early fall planning to do a training about what to look for when going out to check roads during flooding instances
    - i. Bring shovel & rake for clearing culverts as needed
    - ii. Will include Police Department
  - e. Looking into more signage & portable barricades for road closures
- 2. Larry Finnegan will be attending the August 14, 2023 Officer's Meeting to discuss replacing Engine 2

**Qualified Drivers Board:** Tim to create a board in bays showing who is qualified to drive what vehicle.

- Tim will create an 11x17 pdf and send to Ben to print before the next meeting for review
- Organized by driver with checkbox for each apparatus
- Checkbox for CDL.

<u>Pay and Membership Policy</u>: There is a clarification change in the policy regarding gear. Candace to make change and bring revised policy back to next Officer's Meeting for review and approval.

#### **Training:**

- 1. Review email from Bobby Maynard
  - a. VEFR (Vermont Emergency First Responder) is the class, not too difficult of certifications but the requirement is that there be an affiliation with a VT EMS service which we do not have

- 2. Track 10 Qualified Incident Commander
  - HAZMAT Ops Refresher is a long class and holding some people up, would be more effective to schedule an in person class
    - o Rich to call VT Fire Academy to schedule someone to teach the in person course
  - ICS 200 is also a holdup for some people, but it can only be taken online

#### **Upcoming Fire Drills:**

- Aug 2 Snow Lake Lodge Familiarization with building, searches, patient evac, improvised standpipe, flowing water out of ladder
- Aug 16 Tentative walkthrough of Lift Ops building and then can flow some water at Snow Lake
  - o Zack to confirm with Mount Snow

#### **Upcoming SAR Drills:**

• Aug 9 – Search & Carryout at Horace Hill

#### **SAR Gloves**

- Get a variety of sizes and leave in the trailer
- Like the ones with non-slip grip and stretchy

#### ESO:

- Should Officers have access to ESO to enter information immediately after incident?
  - No, continue filling out written reports and allow those who have been appropriately trained to enter it into the system
  - Would be good to see demonstration of what goes into it so those doing written reports can keep needed information in mind
- Candace and Sarah met on 07/11 to review inputting ESO reports

### Gym Equipment: Moving equipment to basement.

- Will need to consolidate equipment to fit smaller space in the basement
- Tim to create survey and have Candace send out to department so we can get info on what pieces of equipment are used the most
- Final layout plan to be completed by September 11

<u>Security Cameras</u>: New monitor has been installed and picking up 5 of the 10 cameras. Cameras are antiquated and we need to upgrade the system. Tim to provide proposal and a quote to Rich (in the \$700 to \$1,000 range).

• Will buy a single camera to start and make sure it works with our existing infrastructure before committing to entire system

<u>Tower</u>: Relocation and switching over of tower was delayed. Anticipated completed by end of June 2023.

• Still not completed and no estimate on time frame

#### **New Radios:**

- Have 11 of them, Zack will get them programmed
- Will be programmed with specific unit ID which will be transmitted to Keene via their emergency button

# **SOG Updates:** Updated SOGs:

**SCBA** - Mickey Kersten – minor changes approved except for:

- SCBA fit test Mickey to research options and bring back to future meeting
- Add respiratory fit test to training for once within each four (4) year span

Mayday - Mike Hescock

PPE – Zack created, officer's unanimously voted to adopt it

**Accountability** – Ben & Mike A created a new board for SAR accountability utilizing green tags

 Ben to look at Techtron for different options that may be available now before finalizing, including different color tags

**Compressor:** Rich Werner to email decision to SB chair regarding the disposal of the old equipment.

## New Compressor

- Bigger than spec'd, will not fit where proposed.
- Will put it in the basement
- Fill station would still be in usual location and compressor will automatically fill bottles, should not need to access the actual compressor on a usual basis
- Rich to ask Highway Dept to get the compressor into the basement for installation

<u>Pay Policy</u>: All officers to review current West Dover Policy on membership and pay and discuss updating in future meeting. Cross reference to job descriptions to assure they are in sync.

• Candace to send out before the next meeting

**<u>Dry Hydrant</u>**: potential to locate a dry hydrant in Tollgate Village. Mickey Kersten to determine what will be needed to install and the cost. Rich Werner to discuss with John Abel

• Parts are in, Rich needs to go to NH to pickup

**Mount Snow**: Discussion on who is permitted to clear alarms

- Invite Dan Toemke to future meeting to discuss who on Mount Snow's staff can call off
- Continue discussion based on MS's feedback

**<u>Fireworks</u>**: Mount Snow request for fireworks on Friday, September 1<sup>st</sup>

- Approved with following conditions:
  - o Mount Snow needs to supply a fire watch during the event
  - o Fire warden has ability to cancel up to noon the day of the event
