#### **Truck Update:**

Next Steps Budget Consideration

**Knox Box:** if someone requests a knox box application, they are located in left file cabinet in Rich's office. Have property owner fill out form, leave check or credit card info, and Rich will sign and submit.

<u>Bridge Posting for Emergency Vehicles</u>: New signs on 39 bridges in Vermont stating load limits. Be aware of the signs and load limits of the vehicle you're driving. As part of 02/02/2022 training, team will detail weight and height of each truck and post info inside vehicle in an area visible to driver for ability to make decision when approaching bridges.

<u>Portable radios</u>: Log all details of problem when the occur (what, when, where, etc.). Suggest that we wait to see if the new tower will help resolve some of the problems.

<u>Flashlights</u>: There are replacement parts on hand (batteries, bulbs and chargers) – ID which ones are failing and schedule fixing as part of future training or drill. Will revisit once that is complete to see what future purchases may be required.

<u>Employment Application</u>: Format approved. Candace picking up material from Jeanette to create packets with application, Job Descriptions and other forms required from the town to keep on hand.

<u>Training Videos</u>: Galen Robinson will be able to work with the team to create the training videos.

Officers to review list and bring suggestions on which trainings should be created into videos by the association:

- 2 SAR hype
- 2 SAR training
- Firefighter Recruitment
- SAR Recruitment

Once completed, these videos will live on the FD page on the town website. Future videos for training can be created by Galen. Record, upload and create training class with test.

  estimated cost would be to complete a total of 3 packs. Ben to bring back to next meeting to
  discuss.

## SAR:

- 02/09 snowmobile training with Vermont Certified Instructor to lead. Stump Jumpers lending 2 machines for training. Email sent to all Firefighters inviting them to drill.
- The team is still working on the State Police training

# **Search & Rescue Trailer Update:**

- Striping and chevrons are on the trailer
- Tim and Ben to work out the "911" wording and "stay back" sticker. Mickey will look for other options to purchase stickers rather than have to have them custom made
- Once the design and estimate are completed, it will be presented to the association
- Interior shelving & desk Ben to get sketch design and list of materials to Rich. Will look to have them built in the spring
