 - Recommend to property owner to do fire watch
 - o If questions/concerns recommend they contact the local Fire Marshall
- Truck Crew Program
 - Looking to start a ladder truck specialty crew.
 - Start with in house interest first,
 - MikeA, Zack, Mickey, Tim, Ben approves of in-house training
 - Training 1 night a week
 - Without pay
 - Hours count towards training
 - Only for those interested
 - Chief's concerns
 - He would like to see a written proposal
 - Especially before opening to outside agencies.
 - "Perfect practice makes perfect action"
