Potential Bidder-

The West Dover Fire Department is looking for bids to resurface the floor at the West Dover Fire House located at 253 Route 100, West Dover, VT.

The Apparatus bays floor as well as the floor in the Silo shall be cleaned and mechanically prepared to achieve an angular profile for re-surfacing utilizing a high performance decorative mosaic epoxy with flake system equal to or better than that offered by Sherwin Williams/General Polymers. Materials specification available upon request.

The successful bidder will be responsible for moving all items in the bay area with the exception of motorized apparatus which moving will be the responsibility of the Fire Department/ Town of Dover. The successful bidder will need to plan to allow 4 of the bays to be occupied by motorized apparatus at night.

The successful bidder will also be responsible for all materials, as well as a thorough clean up after the work is completed. The Fire Chief and or their designee shall determine compliance with the thorough cleaning.

As part of this work the cement wall/ footing that is exposed above the floor shall also be treated to the same appearance as the floor.

All bidders are required to conduct a site visit with the Fire Chief or their designee prior to submitting a proposal for the work. The Fire Chief will make available Thursday May 24 from 10 AM to 11 AM available for site visit. If a potential bidder can't make this date they can contact the Fire Chief for an alternate date however the Town/ Fire Chief is not required to make themselves available at the discretion of the potential bidder, however will do their best to be available.

All bidders will be required to submit with their bids a certificate of insurance showing workmen's comp coverage; A completed 10-99 form; and three letters of reference. All work may commence when the contract has been agreed to by the Dover Select board and must be completed by July 15, 2018.

Payment for these services will be as follows- 30% the day work starts and materials have been delivered to the site; 30% when the job is 50% completed; 30% when the job is completed and the area has been cleaned as described above; 10% within 10 business days during which time the floor will have had traffic and can be inspected by the Fire Department at a regularly scheduled drill.

Any questions or clarifications should be directed to the Fire Chief. He may be contacted at work at 802-380-7731. Any exceptions to the specifications or changes proposed by a prospective bidder shall be included in the proposal for review.

All bids shall be received by 5 PM on Thursday, May 31, 2018. Bids can be mailed to the above address or hand delivered to the Assistant Town Clerk at the Dover Town Office located on Route 100 in West Dover. No faxed or e-mailed bids shall be accepted.

The Town of Dover reserves that right to accept or reject any and all bids and does not have to award the bid to the lowest bidder. The Town also reserves the right to negotiate with any bidder of their choice so as to allow the modification of the equipment to meet with the satisfaction of the department.

The bid will be presented to the Select board for their approval at the June 5, 2018 Select Board meeting after 6:30 PM.
