Single Stream Recycling

No sorting on your end makes recycling quick and easy!

Recyclables should be empty and rinsed clean of food residue. Lids and caps may be loosely replaced on their containers.

Please do not tie newspaper, magazines or cardboard with twine.

Plastic bags and Styrofoam are trash and cannot be recycled!

(Wavy center layer)



Boxboard
(Dry-food boxes, egg cartons, & rolls)



Junk Mail, Periodicals, & Office Paper
(Paper bags, envelopes, & catalogs)

PLASTIC



Plastic Bottles, Jugs, Tubs, & Lids
(Empty kitchen, laundry, & bath containers)

METAL



Aluminum & Steel Cans
(Foil & empty food & beverage cans)

GLASS



Glass Bottles & Jars
(Empty food & beverage bottles & jars)

Food Scraps

Let's Scrap Food Waste!

- Less regular trash
- Preserves resources
- Required by state law
- Gets turned into BrattleGrow compost, enriching soils

Egg shells BPI-Certified compostable bags

Drop off the collected food scraps in the small dumpster at the facility.

Household Trash

Dover requires a \$7 access sticker; \$20 for commercial use. \$2.50 per bag. Disposal fees doubled if no access sticker is present. Purchase stickers at the Town Clerk's Office.

construction debris; scrap metal;
appliances; batteries; electronics; tires;
leaf & yard waste
